Over the past few months, my calls from Tax Comm. and consumers is on the rise about repeat Hologram from dealers. You cannot do this.

A temporary tag shall be issued and placed on the vehicle where the regular tag would normally go, as per D.O.R. rules 560-10-7. The temporary tag may include the dealers company name but the lower two inches of the tag must include an expiration date that is 30 days from the date of the sale. The expiration date shall be written in bold dark print no less than one and one half inches high on a prescribed secure holographic Mylar strip. Documents should be kept in the vehicle confirming the sale date.

If the dealer has not provided the purchaser with a title within five (5) business days prior to the expiration date of the dealer temporary license plate so that the purchaser can register the vehicle and obtain a license plate, the purchasers' county tag agent may grant a 30 day extension of the initial registration period. The "initial registration period" is the 30 day immediately following the date of purchase of a new or used motor vehicle.

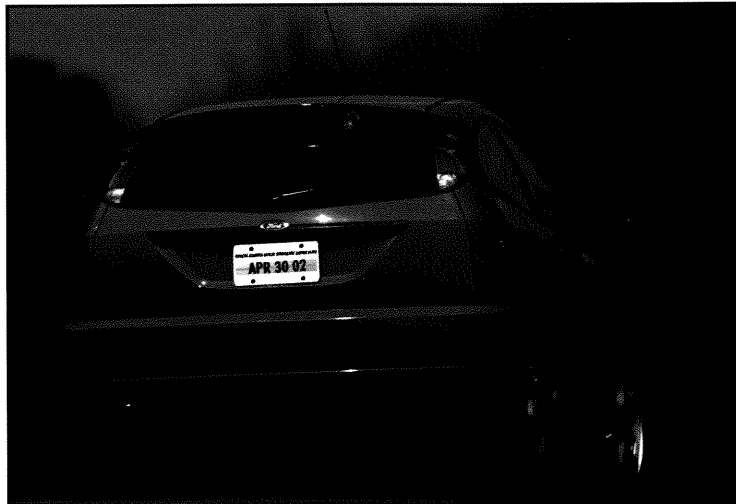
To apply to extend the initial registration period, the

purchaser must do the following:

1) Complete Form T-226, "Application to Extend Initial Registration Period for a Motor Vehicle Purchased from a Georgia Motor Vehicle Dealer". The owner of the Motor Vehicle must sign the T-226.

2) Must submit Form T-226 to the County Tag Agent in the county where the purchaser resides. If the vehicle is used in connection with an established business, then the form must be submitted to the County Tag Agent where the business is located.

A) Form T-226 must be submitted with a copy of the Dealers Temporary license plate that was issued by a Georgia Motor Vehicle Dealer.

HOLOGRAM STICKER

Temporary Tag - If customer does not have a current license plate, a temporary tag shall be issued and placed on the vehicle where the regular tag would normally go, as per D.O.R. rules 560-10-7.
