Here's Why We Do It...

- Experts agree that changing your engine oil & filter regularly promotes long engine life, and maximum value in your investment. It also has a minor impact on your fuel economy. (2% - 3%)
- Your front tires do 100% of your steering and about 80% of the stopping on your vehicle. For these reasons, your normal driving causes uneven wear on the outside edges of your front tires (called the shoulder). We want you and your family to have the safest tires up front. We also properly inflate those tires to give you optimum ride, handling, braking and fuel economy (up to 5%).
- We inspect your brakes to be sure everything is at a safe level.
- We add a pour-in fuel injector cleaner for better fuel economy plus better and safer engine performance
- We inspect your air filter to be sure it is not so dirty as to impact your fuel economy (up to 10%), performance or emissions.
- We inspect your steering and suspension hardware to be sure your vehicle handles and steers safely.
- We also inspect your fuel and exhaust system for dangerous fuel and/or exhaust leaks.
- And, we top off your washer solvent, all your fluids, and lube the door locks and latches.
