

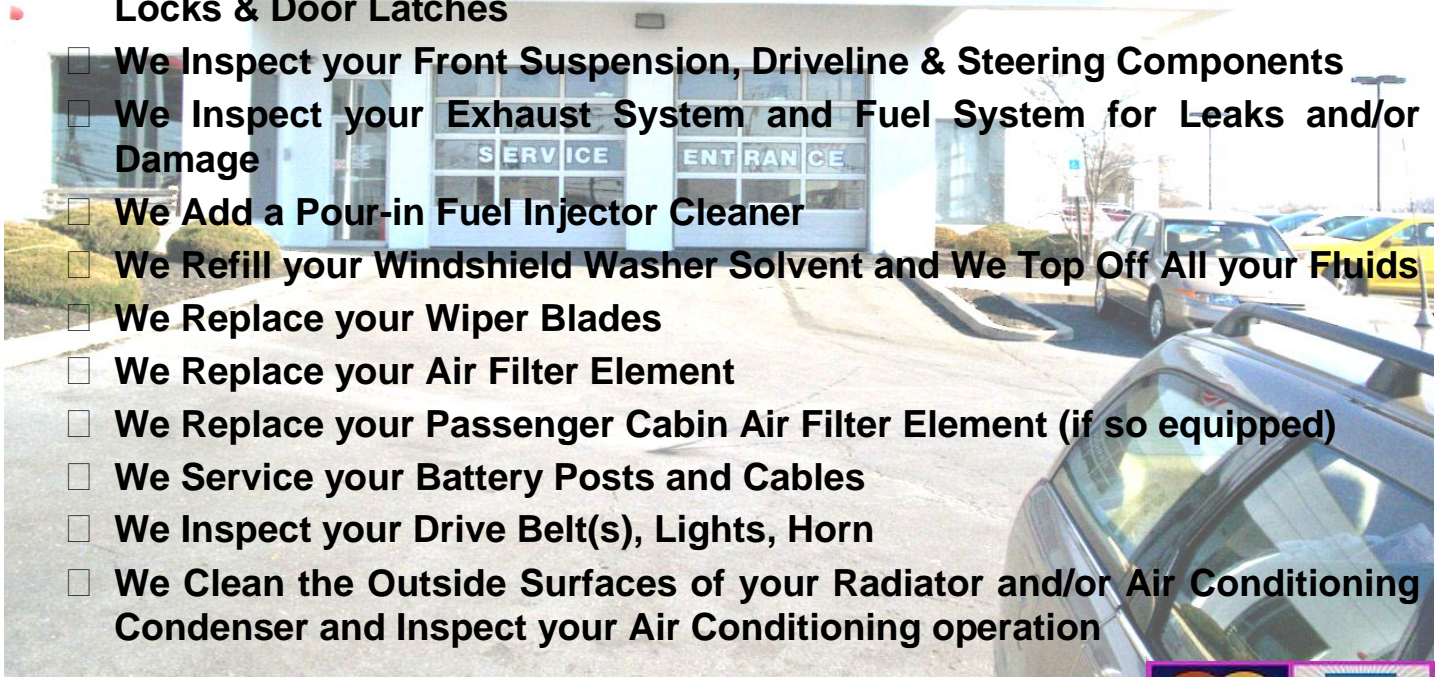
# Holman Saturn *Common Sense* Maintenance Schedule

## GM Products "B" Package

Due every 15,000 miles or 12 months (also due at 30K, 60K, 75K, 105K, 120K 150K, 165K miles etc)

### Here's What We Do...

- We Replace your Engine Oil and Filter
- We Rotate your Tires and Inspect your Tires, Brakes and Brake Hardware & Hydraulics; We Set your Tire Pressures to their Correct Inflation
- We Lubricate your Suspension & Steering Lubrication Points, Door Locks & Door Latches
- We Inspect your Front Suspension, Driveline & Steering Components
- We Inspect your Exhaust System and Fuel System for Leaks and/or Damage
- We Add a Pour-in Fuel Injector Cleaner
- We Refill your Windshield Washer Solvent and We Top Off All your Fluids
- We Replace your Wiper Blades
- We Replace your Air Filter Element
- We Replace your Passenger Cabin Air Filter Element (if so equipped)
- We Service your Battery Posts and Cables
- We Inspect your Drive Belt(s), Lights, Horn
- We Clean the Outside Surfaces of your Radiator and/or Air Conditioning Condenser and Inspect your Air Conditioning operation

Regularly Scheduled Maintenance ensures proper performance of your vehicle, protects your investment, maintains warranty and/or service contract enforcement, and is much more convenient and much less expensive than breakdowns.

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### Here's Why We Do It...

- Experts agree that changing your engine oil & filter regularly promotes long engine life, and maximum value in your investment. It also has a minor impact on your fuel economy. (2% - 3%)
- Your front tires do 100% of your steering and about 80% of the stopping on your vehicle. For these reasons, your normal driving causes uneven wear on the outside edges of your front tires (called the shoulder). We want you and your family to have the safest tires up front. We also properly inflate those tires to give you optimum ride, handling, braking and fuel economy (up to 5%).
- We top off your washer solvent, all your fluids, and lube the door locks and latches.
- We replace your wiper blades for maximum vision in bad weather conditions
- We replace your air filter to be sure you receive optimum fuel economy (up to 10%), performance or emissions.
- We add a pour-in fuel injector cleaner for better fuel economy plus better and safer engine performance
- We replace your Cabin Air Filter to be sure that it is removing the maximum amount of dust particles, pollen, and allergens that can enter into the vehicle's cabin.
- We inspect your steering and suspension hardware to be sure your vehicle handles and steers safely.
- We also inspect your fuel and exhaust system for dangerous fuel and/or exhaust leaks.
- We service your battery connections so that you can get a full charge into and out of your battery for easier starting and proper computer functions.
- We inspect your drive belt because a failure stops everything from operating – charging system, cooling system, power steering, and air conditioning.
- We also inspect all your lights and horn for obvious safety reasons—we want you to be able to see AND *be seen* in low visibility conditions such as night, fog, rain, snow, etc.
- We check and clean your external coolant and air conditioning components for proper operation engine and passenger cooling
- We road test your car to make sure everything is in proper working and safety order

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
