Due every 45,000 miles or 36 months (also due at 90K, 135K, 180K, 225K miles etc)

- We Replace your Wiper Blades
- We Replace your Air Filter Element

- We change your engine oil & filter to promote long engine life, and maximum value in your investment. It also has a minor impact on your fuel economy. (2% - 3%)
- Your front tires do 100% of your steering and about 80% of the stopping on your vehicle. We want you and your family to have the safest tires up front. We also properly inflate those tires to give you optimum ride, handling, braking and fuel economy (up to 5%).
- We inspect your steering and suspension hardware to be sure your vehicle handles and steers safely. We also inspect your fuel and exhaust system for dangerous fuel and/or exhaust leaks.
- We replace your air filter and your PCV valve (HD Trucks) to be sure you receive optimum fuel economy (up to 10%), performance or emissions.
- We replace your Cabin Air Filter to be sure that it is removing the maximum amount of dust particles, pollen, and allergens that can enter into the vehicle's cabin.
- We replace your wiper blades for maximum vision in bad weather conditions
- We top off your washer solvent, all your fluids, and lube the door locks and latches.
- We service your battery connections so that you can get a full charge into and out of your battery for easier starting and proper computer functions.
- We inspect your drive belt because a failure stops everything from operating – charging system, cooling system, power steering, and air conditioning.
- We replace your fuel filter to prevent engine hesitations and/or stalling
- We also inspect all your lights and horn for obvious safety reasons—we want you to be able to see AND be seen in low visibility conditions such as night, fog, rain, snow, etc.
- We check and clean your coolant and air conditioning components for proper air flow operation
- We replace your coolant for maximum engine and transmission protection against corrosion build-up and related heat-caused failures
- We service your automatic transmission (fluid exchange and/or filter replacement) to prevent premature wear and failure due to internal wear and/or damage.
- We replace your spark plugs for better performance, better fuel economy (up to 30%) and lower emissions (at 90,000 miles, 180,000 miles, etc.)
- We road test your car to make sure everything is in proper working and safety order
