Covers tire and wheel damage from potholes, nails, rocks and other road hazards. Coverage for chrome and physical vapor deposition is also available.

What could a repair cost you out of pocket? ³

Anyone who's owned a car knows how expensive tires and wheels can be—let alone potential towing or rental car expenses.

Your out-of-pocket expenses could be substantial:

Tire Replacement:	\$500
Wheel Replacement:	\$1,133
Emergency Roadside Assistance/Towing:	\$124
Rental Car:	\$96

Valuable features of your coverage



Towing Reimbursement

Up to \$50 per day for a maximum of three days during a covered repair or replacement.



Rental Car Reimbursement

Up to \$150 per occurrence for towing expenses on an authorized claim.



Emergency Flat-Tire Assistance Reimbursement

Up to \$50 per occurrence for flat-tire change assistance services, including the installation of your vehicle's inflated spare tire.
