



Introduced in 1991, the Lexus GS is currently in its fourth generation and was all new for the 2013 model year.

It comes with the choice of a 3.5-liter V-6 (GS 350) as well as a hybrid version (GS 450h). The GS 350 comes with an 8-speed automatic transmission on rear-wheel-drive models, and a 6-speed automatic transmission on all-wheel-drive models. The GS 450h has a continuously variable transmission and only comes in rear-wheel drive.

While the design and focus of GS has become sportier as it evolves, it doesn't offer many of the advanced features you'll find on the RLX.

Acura RLX Sport Hybrid SH-AWD advantages over Lexus GS 450h

- Gasoline engine has more horsepower and torque than the GS 450h (310 hp/272 lb-ft vs. 286 hp/254 lb-ft).
- More total system power¹ than the GS 450h (377 hp vs. 338 hp)
- Advanced lithium-ion battery (vs. Nickel Metal Hydride)
- 7-speed Dual Clutch Transmission (vs. Continuously Variable Transmission)
- Standard 12-way power front seats (vs. 10-way; 16-way is optional)
- Standard tri-zone climate controls (vs. dual-zone)
- Standard multi-view rear camera² (vs. single-view)
