

2018 RLX Sport Hybrid SH-AWD vs. 2018 BMW 530e





Introduced in 1972, the BMW 5 Series is currently in its sixth generation and was all new for the 2010 model year. A hybrid version was added in 2012.

It comes with a choice of three turbocharged gasoline engines that include 4-cylinder, inline 6-cylinder and V-8 configurations. A turbocharged diesel engine is also available, as well as a hybrid. An 8-speed automatic transmission is standard on all models, with a choice of rear-wheel drive or xDrive all-wheel drive, depending on the engine.

While BMW's 5 Series has become the benchmark for vehicles in this class, it doesn't offer many of the advanced features you'll find on the RLX.
