How you planted a greener future in your community in 2026



Every year, our communities lose 36 million trees from age, disease, infestation, and extreme weather, including right here in West Warwick, RI.

To invest in the long-term health of our communities, Subaru and retailers like Balise Subaru partnered with the Arbor Day Foundation to provide and distribute 165,000 free trees nationwide since 2025.

In the West Warwick area, tree coverage is currently 40 percent, and you are working to help it grow.

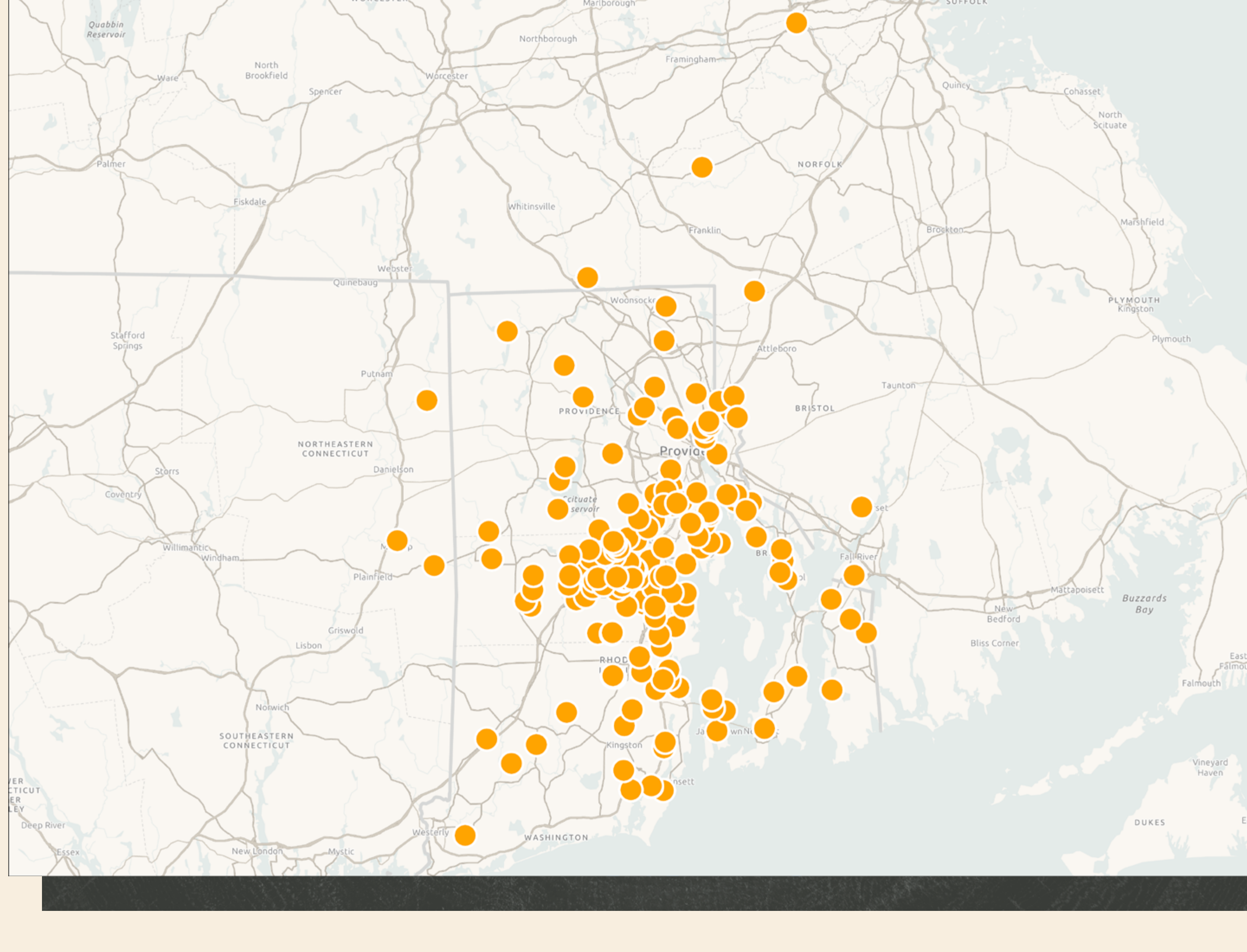
