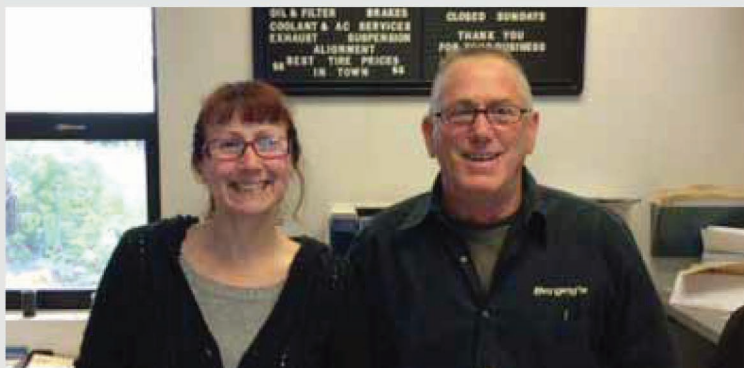

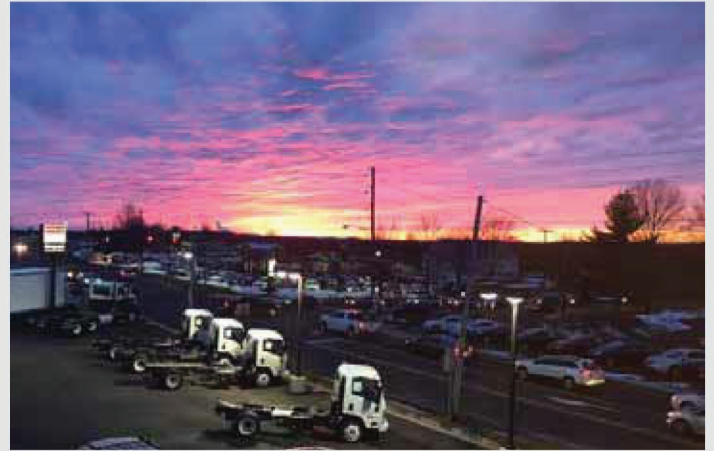

TIPS FOR RELAXATION
