



BUYER'S GUIDE TO THE 2018 JEEP GRAND CHEROKEE

















The Jeep brand name is pretty much synonymous with muscular off-roading capability, nostalgic styling, and an upscale feel. If you're looking to buy a Grand Cherokee for yourself, there are tons of different features and trim levels to consider, and you may need some assistance in deciding which options are best suited for your needs. This *Buyer's Guide to the 2018 Jeep Grand Cherokee* should help!

2018 JEEP GRAND CHEROKEE OVERVIEW

The Grand Cherokee is Jeep's midsize 4-door SUV with seating for five, and it offers one of the brand's most luxurious interiors. Sleek, modern design meets the classic shape and 7-slot grille that Jeep has always boasted, making for a vehicle that's stunningly beautiful inside and out—and did we mention it's also extremely capable of handling just about anything you throw at it?



The vehicle offers 36.3 cubic feet of cargo space when all seats are in use, or you can fold down the back row of seating to access a total cargo capacity of 68.3 cubic feet. The front seat offers 39.9 inches of headroom and 40.3 inches of legroom. In the rear seats, you'll find 39.2 inches of headroom and 38.6 inches of legroom. The Grand Cherokee offers four different engines, a variety of off-roading features, and six different trim levels, all of which we'll explore in this guide.

ENGINE OPTIONS

The Jeep Grand Cherokee offers a variety of engine options, so you can choose the one that has the power you need for your drives and towing jobs. The 2018 model year offers a brand-new engine that's only available in the Trackhawk trim level, which is also a new introduction for 2018, and it's absolutely mind-blowing.



Good

The base engine on the Grand Cherokee is a 3.6L Pentastar[®] V6 that produces 295 horsepower and 260 lb-ft of torque. This engine achieves an EPA-estimated 19 city/26 highway MPG.¹ When properly equipped, this engine has the capability to tow up to 6,200 pounds. This engine can also be equipped with Stop/Start technology that can turn the engine off while idling in order to conserve fuel.





Better

The next step up is an EcoDiesel turbocharged 3.0L V6 that offers 240 horsepower and an impressive 420 lb-ft of torque. This engine is built for fuel efficiency, and offers an EPA-estimated rating of 22 city/30 highway MPG.¹ When properly equipped, this engine can tow up to 7,400 pounds.

Best

The best regular engine is a large 5.7L HEMI[®] V8 that produces 360 horsepower and 390 lb-ft of torque. This powerful engine offers an EPA-estimated 14 city/22 highway MPG.¹ This engine can tow up to 7,200 pounds when properly equipped. This engine choice is available with Fuel Saver Technology.

Insane

This year's new engine, available only in the beastly Trackhawk trim level, is a 6.2L V8 Hellcat that produces an astonishing 707 horsepower and 645 lb-ft of torque.



OFF-ROADING CAPABILITY

Jeep tradition dictates that the brand's offerings should be the most capable offroading vehicles on the market, and each new year, the brand delivers on this expectation. The 2018 Jeep Grand Cherokee offers three different 4x4 drivetrain systems, designed to meet the varying needs of drivers. That means that no matter how you plan to use your Grand Cherokee, there's an option built specifically for you.

Selec-Terrain® Traction Control System

This system offers five different manually operated settings to handle a variety of conditions and terrain. Each of the settings adjusts 12 total vehicle systems, including throttle control, accelerator pedal response, transmission shifting, transfer case operation, traction control, and Electronic Stability Control. Choose from Sport, Snow, Auto, Sand/Mud, and Rock.

Quadra-Lift® Air Suspension System

This system is able to raise your Jeep's ground clearance by up to 10.8 inches with the touch of a button. For easy entry, exit, and loading of the vehicle, you can also lower the suspension by 1.6 inches. There are five different selectable settings for any driving scenario you'll encounter: Park, Aero, Normal, Off-Road I, and Off-Road II.





Selec-Speed® Control

This feature helps when climbing or descending steep grades. The system comes with Hill Start Assist and Hill Descent Control. Hill Start Assist keeps your brakes applied after you've released the brake so that you have time to accelerate before the vehicle can roll backwards. Hill Descent Control monitors throttle, speed, and braking to keep the vehicle under control when you're traveling downhill.

Quadra-Trac I®

This is a full-time system that provides power to the front and rear axles.

Quadra-Trac II®

This full-time system is able to anticipate wheel slip and continuously transfer torque to the wheel with the most traction, helping pull you across rough terrain. You'll get a lowrange setting that's great for crawling over rocks.

Quadra-Drive II®

This full-time system combines Quadra-Trac II[®] with Selec-Terrain[®], offering superior traction in all weather conditions and on all off-road conditions. It comes with an electronic limited-slip differential in the rear so that 100% of the available torque can be directed to a single rear wheel.

TRIM LEVELS

The 2018 Jeep Grand Cherokee is offered in a wide assortment of trim levels, each offering a different collection of features and technologies. These are the six main trim levels, although Jeep may occasionally release special edition versions on top of these offerings...

Laredo

This trim level is well-equipped for a base trim, and comes with a 3.6L V6 engine and an 8-speed automatic transmission. The Laredo is equipped with 17-inch alloy wheels, automatic headlights, fog lights, and heated mirrors to keep your rear vision clear even





in bad weather conditions. Rear parking sensors and a rearview camera make backing up in a crowded parking lot and parallel parking in the city a breeze. For convenience, you'll have standard keyless entry and ignition, allowing you to enter and start the car without having to dig through your pocket or purse for the key.

Inside the cabin, you'll have dual-zone automatic climate control to keep you comfortable, and an upscale leather-wrapped tilt and telescopic steering wheel. Tech features include a 5-inch touchscreen display, 6-speaker sound system, and a variety of ways to connect with your entertainment, including Bluetooth[®], a USB port, and an auxiliary audio jack.

Limited

On the Limited trim and above, you can keep the base engine, or you can opt for one of the two more powerful regular engines, either the 5.7L V8 or the 3.0L V6, both of which come with an 8-speed automatic transmission. You'll upgrade to 18-inch wheels for greater ground clearance, and you'll have the option to remotely start the engine, so the car's warmed up and ready to go when you are.

Additional standard features include auto-dimming driver-side and rearview mirrors, driver's seat memory settings, a heated steering wheel, and a convenient power liftgate. You'll also upgrade to leather upholstery, 8-way power adjustable front seats, and add a 115-volt power outlet and a second USB port.

Trailhawk[®]

The Trailhawk[®] is the Grand Cherokee trim that's built to handle any treacherous off-roading scenario without breaking a sweat. You'll gain off-roading tires, standard Quadra-Drive II[®], a Quadra-Lift[®] adjustable air suspension, Selec-Speed[®] control, and other Trailhawk[®]-specific



tuning. Hill Ascent and Descent Control are standard, as well as an electronic limitedslip rear differential, underbody skid plates, power-folding side mirrors, and an upgraded instrument cluster display with special off-roading features. Inside the cabin, you'll gain an 8.4-inch touchscreen display, a 9-speaker sound system, and ventilated front seats to keep you cool.

Overland

The Overland adds to the Limited's features with power-folding side mirrors, and the upgraded 8.4-inch display and 9-speaker sound system. In addition, you'll get some added luxuries, including automatic wipers, xenon headlights with auto leveling, automatic high beam control, LED daytime running lights and fog lights, and a dual-pane panoramic sunroof. You'll also gain a navigation system to keep you from getting lost, HD Radio[™], 20-inch wheels, and a power-adjustable steering wheel.

Summit

The Summit comes with all the Overland's standard equipment, plus polished 20-inch wheels, headlamp washers, and illuminated door sills. For safety, you'll gain front parking sensors, a self-parking system, Adaptive Cruise Control, Blind Spot Monitoring with Rear Cross-Traffic Alert, a Forward Collision Mitigation System, and Lane Departure Warning. The addition of noise-reducing acoustic glass windows and active noise-cancelling technology keep the cabin serenely quiet, and you'll gain luxurious upgraded leather upholstery with stylish diamond-quilted accents.

Trackhawk

The Trackhawk is Jeep's new 2018 offering, designed with the most powerful engine in the midsize SUV class. This trim level is able to travel over pavement at incredible speeds, going from 0-60 MPH in just 3.5 seconds. Standard Brembo[®] sporty yellow brakes provide power to bring the car back from 60-0 in just 114 feet. Special race-inspired seat bolsters keep you comfortably in place during spirited maneuvers, and the interior of the car is covered with beautiful accents, including carbon fiber trim.
