



Volvo Warning Light Symbols For Mild Hybrid Models

Red Critical warning — pull over and seek immediate service



Airbag Fault Warning

An issue has been found with the airbags, potentially compromising occupant safety.



Collision Risk Warning

There is a potential collision risk involving another car, pedestrian, cyclist, or large animal.



Electrical System Fault Warning

A defect has been identified in the car's electrical system. Immediate service is highly recommended.



High Engine Temperature

The engine temperature is excessively high and at risk of overheating.



Parking Brake Warning

A steady light means the parking brake is engaged, while a flashing light signals a fault in the parking brake system.



Warning

An issue has been detected that may compromise safety or impact the vehicle's drivability.

Amber (Orange) Caution — service is needed as soon as possible



ABS Warning

Indicates ABS is disengaged. Basic braking still works, but wheel lock-up protection is lost.



Collision Risk System Issue

The collision risk system is either unavailable or operating with limited functionality.



Headlight System Malfunction

An error has been noticed in the headlight system and may affect the vehicle's visibility and safety during night driving or adverse weather.



Brake System Warning

A critical error has been detected in the brake system. Immediate service is highly recommended.



Driver Alert Warning

A flashing light signals that the system has recognized signs of drowsiness and recommends taking a break. A steady light indicates an irregularity within the system.



Emergency Call

Problem with the emergency call system that may prevent the vehicle from automatically contacting emergency services.



Low Oil Pressure

The engine oil pressure is critically low.



Seatbelt Reminder

A seatbelt is not worn by one or more occupants in the vehicle.



Brake System Warning

Warns of a brake system issue. Refer to the message center for details and seek service immediately.



Emission Control System Warning

A malfunction has been identified in the emission control system. Possible engine misfire or catalytic converter issue.



High Speed Warning

You are currently driving at a high speed. Please reduce your speed to maintain safety and comply with traffic regulations.

Amber (Orange) — continued Caution — service is needed as soon as possible**Information ("i")**

Often accompanied by other lights, it signals a non-critical issue. Check the instrument cluster for details.

**Rear Fog Light On**

Confirms that the rear fog lights are activated, helping drivers behind you see the car in dense fog.

**Stability System Alert**

Flashing means traction control is active; steady means there's a fault, and service may be needed.

**Tire Pressure Warning**

One or more tires may be underinflated. A flashing light followed by a steady illumination signals a system glitch or an inability to measure tire pressure.

**Lane Keeping Aid Alert / Intervention**

The Lane Keeping Aid system is either alerting you or actively assisting with steering corrections.

**Reduced Performance Alert**

The vehicle is currently operating with reduced performance. This limitation is in place to protect critical systems.

**Stability System Off**

The stability control system is currently deactivated. Use caution on slick roads.

Blue High beam indicator**Automatic High Beam Active**

Shows the automatic high beams are on and actively switching between high and low beams based on traffic.

**Manual High Beam On**

The manual high beams are currently activated. Be sure to switch them off when approaching other vehicles to avoid hindering drivers.

Green Information / active system — no action needed**Automatic Hold**

The automatic hold braking function is engaged, keeping the vehicle stationary without needing to keep your foot on the brake pedal.

**Left- & Right-Hand Indicators**

A flashing green arrow with a click sound indicates a left/right turn or lane change. Rapid flash may mean a bulb is out.

White / Gray Status indicators**Automatic High Beam Enabled**

The automatic high beam system is enabled and ready to adjust your headlights based on surrounding traffic.

**Car Key Not Detected**

The vehicle was started, but the key was not detected. Ensure the key is inside the car and functioning properly.

**Driver Alert**

The Driver Alert system is active and is monitoring your driving behavior for signs of fatigue or inattentiveness.

**Hill Descent Control Enabled**

Hill Descent Control is enabled, helping maintain a steady, controlled speed while driving down steep or slippery slopes.

**Lane Keeping Aid Active (Markings Detected)**

Confirms that the Lane Keeping Aid system is tracking lane markers and ready to assist with gentle steering corrections.

**Lane Keeping Aid Active (Markings Not Detected)**

The system is functioning, but lane lines are not currently being found by the sensors.

**Rain Sensor**

Signifies the rain sensor is operational, adjusting the wiper speed as needed.

**Traction Battery Charging**

The traction battery is actively charging, replenishing the electric power supply for future driving.

**Traction Battery Maintaining Charge**

The traction battery is holding its current charge level.
