

THE OFFICIAL CORPORATE PINEWOOD DERBY RULES & REGULATIONS

"The Pinewood Derby was started to promote learning, competition, and sportsmanship." - Second Place finisher

A Corporate Pinewood Derby race is a metaphor for business. Competition sorts the weak and strong - the fast and the slow. Competition drives us to do our best. The goal of this event is to WIN and make your company look good. If you don't win, you can say the event was about having FUN. Yeah, that too.

Sportsmanship involves both following the rules, and how to compete in our Pinewood Derby. No matter how your car performs, you want to compete in a manner that will allow you to feel good in the days to follow. Why is it important to follow the rules at the Pinewood Derby? It makes winning fair and square.

The purpose of the rules and regulations is to provide a reasonable and level playing field for all racing contestants. Please read and heed the rules!

Eligibility of Contestants and Cars

The Corporate Pinewood Derby is open to ALL businesses, groups, organizations and individuals in the Western Nevada Community.

Cost: \$250 per car.

Race Day: **Friday, August 28**. Car check-in begins at 3:00pm. The race will be conducted between 4:00-6:00 p.m. at the new Dolan Lexus. Refreshments and beverages will be provided. This is an adult activity and it is not the intention for children to attend.

THE RULES

- 1. Only cars created and built from the Official BSA Pinewood Derby kit will be allowed!
- ALL CARS are encouraged to have a SPONSOR or organization's name and/or logo visible on the exterior of the car. This suggestion exists for ease of identification and also for media coverage and marketing of your company during and after the event.
- 3. The car weight shall not exceed 5.0 ounces. The official race scale shall be considered final.
- 4. The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2".
- 5. The car must have 1" clearance between the wheels.
- 6. The car must have 3/8" clearance underneath the body.
- 7. The wood provided in the kit must be used. The block may be shaped any way that is desired.
- 8. The wheels supplied with the kit must be used.
- 9. The axles supplied with the kit must be used. They may be polished or lubricated.
- 10. If, during a race, a car leaves the track without interfering with its opponent, it shall be considered to have ended its heat at that point and the team will be assessed a DUI fine.
- 11. If, during a race, no car reaches the finish line on the track, the car which went the farthest in its lane shall be declared as the heat winner.

- 12. If, during a race, a car leaves its lane and, in so doing, interferes with another racer, then the car at fault shall be declared to have lost the race heat. There will be a rerun of all cars not at fault. The interfering car's team will then have to buy drinks for victim car(s) team members.
- 13. Cars will race either in an open division, or a division of similar businesses (legal, health care, automotive, casinos, etc).
- 14. The race will use a single elimination format.

Awards:

Awards will be given to division winners and top three fastest cars overall.

- a. There will be three (3) racing awards presented to the fastest cars, 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- b. There will be awards to the fastest car in each division (based on the number of entries).
- c. Certificates will be awarded to cars for the following judged categories. Judging is to be done by a panel selected on race day. Note, not all categories may be awarded, and not all certificates in each category may be awarded. Additional certificates may be awarded for special circumstances:
 - a. Best Overall Company Image
 - b. Fastest Car Standing Still
 - c. Best Engineered Car
 - d. Best Support Cheer Team
 - e. Most Unique Design
 - f. Most Realistic Design
 - g. Dog Ugliest Car
 - h. Best Sport Theme Car
 - i. Most Flashing Lights (or Most Lights if no flashing lights)
 - j. Best Wolf Pack Themed
 - k. Best Resemblance to a NASCAR
 - I. Best Non-car Car
