What?

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Non-affiliates we share with can include: finance companies and insurance companies.	
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include: finance companies and insurance companies.
