- Please replace all fuel used.
- Vehicles must be returned on the day repairs are completed or when scheduled. The customer will be responsible for a daily rental charge if the vehicle is returned after the scheduled time.
- Due to insurance regulations, you must be 21 to operate a loaner.
- Only the person(s) listed on the courtesy vehicle agreement form is/are eligible to operate a loaner.
- Any driver of courtesy vehicle will need to present a valid driver's license.
- All traffic and parking tickets are the responsibility of the driver.
- We kindly ask all guests to refrain from smoking in courtesy vehicles. Guests are responsible for all charges for cleaning required in relation to smoking. Please understand that our loaner program is a dealer program offered by, and at the expense of, Volkswagen of Orange Park. We thank you for your continued patronage and for abiding by these policies that make it possible to provide this service to you.

### The Benefit of Proper Inflation

With the right amount of air pressure, you will achieve optimum tire performance. This means your tires wear longer, save fuel and help prevent accidents. The "right amount" of air is the pressure specified by the vehicle manufacturer, which may be different on the front than the rear tires on your particular model car or SUV.

It is difficult to tell just by looking at radial tires whether they are underinflated. Failure to maintain correct inflation pressures may result in rapid wear and uneven tread wear, improper vehicle handling and excessive heat buildup, which may cause tire failure.
