Steve McQueen's epic car chase in the 1968 movie "Bullitt" made his dark green fastback the most famous Mustang in Hollywood. Some movie buffs still consider that scene to be one of the greatest movie car chases ever.

Mustang BULLITT limited editions have been built previously in 2001 and 2008-09. They have traditionally featured upgraded suspensions, intakes and exhausts, brakes and unique wheels ... as well as the trademark Dark Highland Green exterior color.
