The CX-5 is Mazda's bestselling vehicle in the U.S. and has surpassed 2 million units sold worldwide. Industry accolades for the CX-5 are numerous and include IIHS <u>Advanced Pedestrian</u> <u>Crash Prevention Rating</u>, *Car and Driver's* <u>10 Best Trucks</u> <u>and SUVs</u> for 2019 and IIHS <u>Top Safety Pick+ Honors</u>.
