As a further statement to our quality commitment, your Ford original equipment replacement sheet metal part comes with a lifelong guarantee against holes caused by corrosion. If the original equipment replacement Ford sheet metal part ever develops inside-to-outside corrosion perforation, Ford warrants to the original repairing vehicle owner that an authorized Ford Motor Company dealer will repair or replace the part at our option at no cost to you for as long as you own the vehicle. You must simply take your vehicle to the nearest authorized Ford Motor Company dealer and present the original repair order. The local Ford Motor Company dealer will either render your service directly or arrange for service to be provided.

The repair or replacement will be completed at no charge to you. This warranty does not cover corrosion perforation caused by improper installation, abuse, accident, neglect or any other event that would not be considered normal use of your vehicle.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which may vary from state to state.
