



E-Ray Shatters 1/4 Mile E.T....

The falling of one and setting of another new elapsed time benchmark at the dragstrip is something we always enjoy seeing or at least hearing about. In the wake of all the new records that were set on HOT ROD Drag Week 2024, comes word of a new quickest quarter-mile e.t. for Chevrolet's 2024 C8 hybrid E-Ray Corvette.



Boost District's 2024 Chevy Corvette E-Ray puts ZR1s and Nissan GTRs on notice with three 9.38 quarter-mile blasts at Texas Motorplex.

Roshan Poptani and the crew at Boost District in Midlothian, Texas, took the company's street-driven twin-turbocharged beast and sent it down the Texas Motorplex dragstrip, tripping the e.t. clocks at 9.38 at 148 mph ... three times (9.5x at 151 mph is the car's previous best)!

We are not the official keepers of this type of niche "world" record (the internet is), but Roshan says the performance makes his 1,030-all-wheel-drive-horsepower (870 hp rear/160 hp front) Vette the quickest, fastest C8 E-Ray (with stock internals) on the planet over 1,320 feet.

Record or not, it's very stout performance for a 6.2-liter GM LT2 V-8 engine with stock heads, cam, connecting rods (the pistons are forged Lingenfelter Performance Engineering slugs), and an exhaust system that still has catalytic converters intact. The record e.t. was also achieved with new 20x11-inch and 19x13-inch wheels, dressed in Toyo Proxes 888R and Mickey Thompson ET Drag Radial Pro tires at the front and rear of the hybrid Corvette.

The C8 Corvette lineup now consists of four unique models and together they provide some fascinating facts, these are our ten favorites.W ith the introduction of the 2025 ZR1, the C8 Corvette family now consists of four distinct models. And each one is special in its own way. There is not a loser in the bunch. The performance starts at simply breathtaking with the Stingray and tops out at downright cartoon-like with the ZR1. Your budget and priorities will determine which is the best for you. However, what if you look at them as a collective? We decided to do just that, and we were fascinated by what we found. The C8 Corvette family produces some staggering stats. They also have an impressive collection of features. We picked out our ten most surprising facts about the C8 Corvette family and are sharing them with you here today.

1. Nearly 3,000 Horsepower Combined

The C8 Stingray, E-Ray, Z06 and ZR1 have a combined output of 2,884 horsepower. That is more than you would get out of a Top Fuel Dragster in the 1970s. Sure, the ZR1 is top of the heap. With an astounding 1,064 horsepower, it alone represents more than one third of the total power output. But the E-Ray and Z06 are both above 650 and even the Stingray is no slouch at 495. This is a Corvette lineup that is simply loaded with power.

2. Slowest Model Hits 60 MPH in 3 Seconds

Let's take a moment to remember and respect the Stingray. With the Z06, E-Ray and ZR1 hype it is easy to forget about the Stingray. But the "entry level" Corvette is blisteringly quick. You are looking at 3 seconds or less to 60 mph for the slowest Corvette you can buy. The quickest are in the mid 2 second range. The ZR1 will top 215 mph. Every Corvette in

the lineup is capable of incredible performance. It is impossible to buy a slow one.

3. Horsepower Per Dollar Ratio

We started this list with an astounding horsepower figure. But what is even more impressive is how inexpensive that power is. Nobody is claiming that the Corvette is cheap, but in the world of high-performance automobiles, it is amazing value. The C8 Stingray with the Performance Exhaust option



makes 495 horsepower and has an MSRP of \$72,880. That is \$147 dollars per horsepower. For the sake of comparison, a new Porsche 911 Carrera has 388 horsepower and has an MSRP of \$122,095. That is \$315 per horsepower. You pay more than twice as much for those German horses.

4. Every Model has a Convertible Option

Some people just love that wind in their hair, top-down feeling that you can only get in a true convertible. And every single Corvette model is available as a convertible. That includes the track-focused Z06 and truly insane ZR1. With the C8 Corvette you are not limited to specific models if you want a convertible. Of course, the first Corvettes were all convertibles. Today you have a choice of coupe or convertible, no matter which model you want.

5. Four Different Powerplants

Another incredible aspect of the current C8 lineup is that each model has its own method of propulsion. The LT2 in the Stingray is a traditional pushrod, cross-plane crank 6.2L V8. The E-Ray uses that same engine, but supplements it with a permanent-magnet electric motor mounted at the front axle. It is the first hybrid Corvette in history. The Z06 uses a flat-plane crank LT6 V8 engine that produces a screaming 670 horsepower. The ZR1 uses an LT7 based on the LT6. But it is strengthened to handle the additional power that is achieved with a pair of turbochargers. Pushrod cross-plane crank V8, hybrid, flat-plane crank V8, or twin-turbo flat-plane crank. You decide. Corvette offers them all.

6. Most Powerful Model has Double HP of Least Powerful

It is not uncommon in the sports car world for there to be more powerful variants available. But typically, the gap between the least powerful and most powerful is significant but not staggering. In the C8 Corvette family, the power



difference is staggering. The ZR1 has 569 more horsepower than an already powerful C8 Stingray. Again, to use Porsche as a comparison, the 911 Turbo S has 252 more horsepower than the base Carrera. That is a significant 65 percent increase. But the ZR1 is an astonishing 115 percent more powerful than the Stingray.

7. C8 Sales


GM has sold about as many C8 Corvettes in the first 4 model years of the C8 (2020 - 2023) as the first 13 model years (1953 - 1965) of Corvette production. So, after 70+ years the enthusiasm for the Corvette has not waned. If anything, the Corvettes of today are more popular than ever.

8. Over 8 Feet of Combined Rear Tire Width

This is a fun one. Maybe a bit pointless, but still fun.

The C8 Corvettes have some fat rear tires on them.

The Stingray has the smallest rear tires with a still substantial 305 mm width. The ZR1, Z06 and E-Ray all use massive 345 mm wide rear tires. So, if you were to stack a set of rear tires from each C8 Corvette models on top of each other you would have a stack of tires that would be 8.8 FEET high! That means it would be just over a foot short from reaching an NBA basketball rim. That is a lot of rubber on the back of just four cars.





9. A Collection of Firsts

The C8 lineup is loaded with a number of firsts for the Corvette. The C8 is the first mid-engine Corvette. It is the first offered solely with an automatic transmission. With the E-Ray we got the first all-wheel drive, and the first hybrid Corvette. With the ZR1 we got the first turbocharged factory Corvette and the first 9 second Corvette. The C8 Z06 features the first-ever use of continually variable (as opposed to just open/closed) exhaust valves. It is also the first Corvette to be fitted with a flat-plane crank engine. And those are just a few of the highlights. The C8 Corvette is truly like no other Corvette that has come before it.

10. A Collection of Lasts!!!!! Don't Cry Corvetters, it could happen???


For this one, we are speculating a bit about the future of the Corvette, but we are fairly confident that when the C8 generation comes to a close, a number of things will be gone forever. The C8 generation is likely the last one without a fully electric model. It is also likely that the C8 generation will be the last to offer just a 2-seat sports car. There have been rumors that GM will expand the lineup to include SUVs and other models. Also, it is likely that we will never again see a naturally aspirated V8 without some sort of electric assistance. The flat-plane LT6 is almost certainly going to be the last of its kind. We are not saying that the C9 generation is going to be worse than the C8 but it is going to be different for sure.

Miami Corvette Thief Gets Stuck!!!

A Corvette owner in Miami Beach has captured a video showing a would-be thief begging for help after getting stuck inside his sports car.

The footage taken by Julio Solano appears to show suspect Ravesh Rabindranauth asking him "Can I get out?" after the 33-year-old allegedly broke into his Corvette on Monday while it was parked in a garage, according to WPLG.

"No, you can't get out, we [are] calling the cops, what do you mean for what? This is grand theft auto, are you trying to steal



my car, what are you doing?" Solano is heard telling Rabindranauth, who is sitting in the driver's seat.

"My brother, this is not your car, this is my car," Solano tells him.


Police then are seen rolling up to the Corvette and taking Rabindranauth into custody.

It's unclear how Rabindranauth got into the Corvette, but Solano told the station that "The car's electrical components don't function without the keys, and fortunately, he didn't know about the manual door release under the seat."

Rabindranauth is <u>now charged with</u> burglary of an unoccupied conveyance and is being held on \$2,500 bond.

To Buy A Corvette or Not???

It turns out you don't have an excuse for not owning a Chevy Corvette. At least, that's the rather persuasive argument made by a Corvette meme that's been making the rounds on social media lately. Even the unemployed are not exempt from owning this sports car. Here's a look at the meme itself.



Per this Corvette meme, if you don't already own a Corvette, you may have been squandering your funds on things like groceries and utilities when you should have been using that cash to buy one. After all, who needs to eat three meals a day? Maybe you were so concerned with heating your home last winter when you could have just thrown on some extra sweaters and used that money you wasted on the gas or electric bill and bought a Corvette. You could be plenty warmed by an engine that puts out over 1,000 horsepower anyway. It comes down to having the right priorities, people.

USA Allocates \$3B for Battery Manufacturing Sector

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has announced plans to allocate \$3 billion toward 25 battery manufacturing projects across 14 states, as part of the Biden administration's effort to shift the critical battery supply chain away from reliance on China.





vehicles (EVs), following the adoption of new U.S. EV tax credit rules.

The funding is set to generate a total of \$16 billion in investments and create around 12,000 jobs in construction and production. The awarded projects cover a wide array of sectors, including battery-grade critical minerals, battery manufacturing, and recycling.

Key projects include Albemarle receiving \$67 million to produce anode material for next-generation lithium-ion batteries in North Carolina. Honeywell was awarded \$126.6 million for a facility in Louisiana focused on producing electrolyte salts for lithium batteries. Clarios Circular Solutions will receive \$150 million to recycle lithium-ion battery scrap in partnership with SK ON and Cosmo Chemical.

Several projects also focus on critical mineral extraction using advanced Direct Lithium Extraction (DLE) technology, with SWA Lithium and TerraVolta Resources receiving \$225 million each for lithium production.

This funding initiative aims to secure U.S. mineral and battery independence, paving the way for advancements in solid-state and nextgen battery technologies. These efforts are crucial for meeting the nation's climate goals and reducing reliance on China, which currently dominates much of the global battery supply chain.



GM Recalls "Half Million Trucks/SUVs"-Brake Flaw

General Motors is recalling over 449,000 SUVs and pickup trucks from model years 2023-2024 due to a software issue in the electronic brake control module.

This problem can prevent the vehicle from displaying a warning light when there is a loss of brake



fluid, which could lead to reduced braking performance and increase the risk of a crash.

As such, these vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard number 135, "Light Vehicle Brake Systems."

The affected vehicles include:

2023-2024 Cadillac Escalade and Escalade ESV, Chevrolet Silverado 1500, Chevrolet Tahoe and Suburban 1500, 2023-2024 GMC Yukon and 2023 GMC Sierra 1500.

Toyota Recalls Certain SUV's Over Safety Issues...

Toyota is recalling tens of thousands of its vehicles over a <u>potential safety issue</u> in some of its newer models.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration announced the recall, which pertains only to 2023-24 Corolla Cross Hybrid vehicles, on Friday.



In a press release published last week, Toyota said that some of the Corolla Cross Hybrid automobiles will mistakenly brake abruptly in some instances.

"In certain situations, during brake application when turning a corner, a driver may temporarily experience a hard brake pedal that can cause the stopping distance to be more than expected," Toyota explained. "This can increase the risk of a crash."The auto manufacturer is recalling 50,000 vehicles in North America, including 41,000 in the U.S.

Rare Canadian Corvette Stripped for Parts...

A bizarre discovery was made on a dirt road in Clearview Township, just outside of Barrie, Ont.

A resident, who didn't wish to be identified, said he came across the shell of a Corvette, gutted and lying in the middle of the road draped in yellow police tape on Wednesday.

"We do have the odd old chair and couch thrown out here, but this is the first time I saw a car," he said.

The luxury sports vehicle, stripped of its parts, was found on Sideroad 9/10 Sunnidale near Concession Road 2 in New Lowell. Residents in the area believe it was dumped on the road sometime overnight.

Niagara police confirmed with CTV News the vehicle is a rare 2019 Chevy Corvette ZR1 convertible, believed to be only one of three such vehicles in all of Canada, reported stolen from a collector in Grimsby, Ont., on August 15.



"It has been secured for forensic examination," Niagara police said in an email to CTV News. "We will be working with the OPP over the course of the ongoing investigation." Police say this rare 2019 Chevy Corvette ZR1 convertible, believed to be only one of three such vehicles in all of Canada, was reported stolen from a collector in Grimsby, Ont., on August 15, 2024.

As of now, it is unknown if there are any suspects in the investigation.




