Dinner at Giuseppe's and Kitchen 86 then off McCallum!



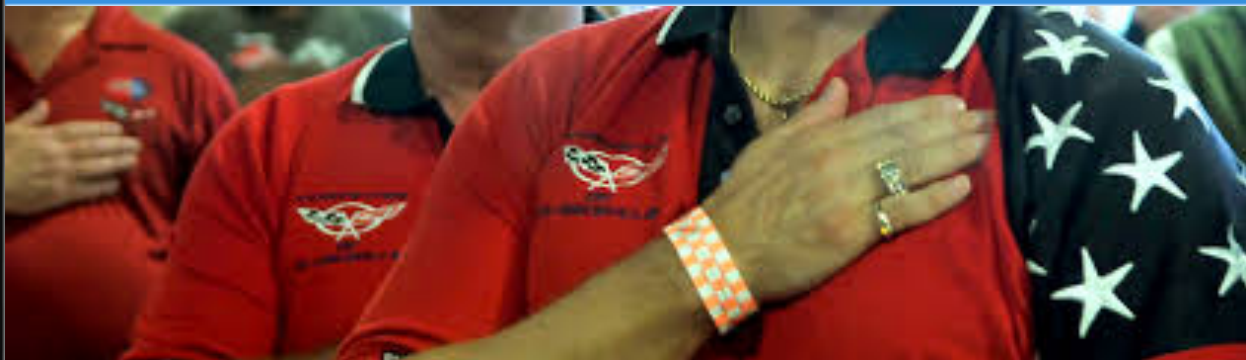
