Corvette Racing at Sebring: What Might Have Been..

SEBRING, Fla. (March 20, 2021) – Corvette Racing ended an up-and-down day with fourth- and fifthplace class finishes in the Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring presented by Advance Auto Parts. Both



Chevrolet Corvette C8.Rs faced adversity throughout, and the team nearly won for the 13th time at Sebring International Raceway.

The No. 3 Mobil 1/SiriusXM Corvette C8.R of Antonio Garcia, Jordan Taylor and Nicky Catsburg placed fourth in the GT Le Mans (GTLM) category after leading much of the day in the second round of the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship. Garcia began on the class pole position, and the trio controlled from the outset and led 211 of 334 laps. After winning the season-opening Rolex 24 At Daytona, the No. 3 Corvette team appeared on its way to a Florida sweep before Garcia was spun from the lead with less than 10 minutes remaining.

On the opposite side of the Corvette garage, the No. 4 Corvette C8.R trio of Tommy Milner, Nick Tandy and Alexander Sims had a day to forget. Beginning the race second in GTLM, the No. 4 C8.R developed an electrical problem from the outset that hampered the Corvette's performance. Milner, Tandy and Sims – who finished second in GTLM at Daytona – were fifth in class Saturday at Sebring.

Garcia drove the final 2.5 hours and attempted to work his way through traffic when he was forcefully hit under braking by the second-place GTLM car and sent spinning out of the hairpin Turn 7. The damage was too great, and the No. 3 Corvette missed the podium.

The outcome spoiled a weekend in which Corvette Racing and Chevrolet celebrated a 25-year technology partnership with Mobil 1. Both of the Corvette C8.Rs sported liveries that matched the Mobil 1 brand.

Corvette Racing's next event is the Six Hours of Spa in the FIA World Endurance Championship on May 1. Then on to Mid Ohio May 14-16.

Corvette Racing Enters 24 Hours Of Le Mans....

Corvette Racing has confirmed it will enter two cars in the 89th running of the 24 Hours of Le Mans this August.

Race organizers released the complete 62-car entry list for the 24 Hours of Le Mans



this week, which included two entries from Corvette Racing. The American squad will return to Le Sarthe for the first time since 2019 after it skipped out on last year's event due to COVID-19, fielding its usual No. 63 and No. 64 entries in the GTE Pro class.

This year's running of the 24 Hours of Le Mans will be held a little later than its usual June date and is currently scheduled for August 21st and 22nd. The event was originally set to be held on June 6th, however race organizers at the Automobile Club de l'Ouest (ACO) announced the revised August date this week, which was put in place with the hope of eventually being able to host fans at the track.

"Holding the Le Mans 24 Hours behind closed doors for the second year running would be unthinkable," said Pierre Fillon, ACO president. "We are working very hard to put on a safe event, with all the necessary health precautions in place."

Corvette Racing competed in the 24 Hours of Le Mans every year from 2000 to 2019 and only failed to show up last year after pandemic-related complications forced it to withdraw from the race. The team has racked up eight Le Mans class victories in that time, serving as a consistent thorn in the side of rivals from Porsche, Ferrari, Ford, Aston Martin and BMW, among others.

C8 Z06 Corvette Spotted...

After Chevrolet released the C8 Corvette, everyone started wondering if and when we'd see a Z06. We do know that the Z06 is expected to debut later this year; with some sources claiming it may arrive in July. We also



know that the C8 Corvette Z06 is going to be a monster of performance. It is going to run a naturally aspirated 5.5 liter flat-plane crank V8, and should be pumping out 615 to 625 horses and 480 pound-feet of torque, with a 9,000 rpm redline.

C8 Z06 test mules have been spotted, albeit few and far between. But one member of our Forums happened upon an incredible sight. In a thread entitled "Pretty Sure I Just Saw and Heard the New Z06" member Shooter aka Edward Bowling captured a Z06 mule on camera and video. The C8 Z06 was covered and followed by a pair of C8s ... and probably a few Corvette engineers. Even better, he actually captured *two* Z06 mules in the video.

"Didn't notice the covered car at first, was too busy looking at the yellow one," he writes. "When they were leaving I noticed how wide the tires were. I swear it sounded like a manual transmission. The yellow car had computers set up for monitoring. Didn't really think about it being a Z06 'til I heard it leave."

Members of the forums were quick to break it down. From the shots, it appears that there are side skirts, a center exhaust with three exhaust tips, and the covered wheels possibly hiding carbon fiber rims. We know that the Z06 will borrow a lot of styling and aero design from the C8.R, and will have Michelin Pilot Sport Cup 2 tires.

Bottom line: The 2022 C8 Corvette Z06 is going to be a savage. Though interestingly, it will offer less power than the C7 Corvette Z06 which had a 6.2 later supercharged and intercooled LT4 V8 engine which produces a scorching 650 hp at 6,400 rpm and 650 lb ft at 3,600. Video link below.....

Best Looking Corvette Every C2! Maybe Not.....

The 1963 <u>Corvette</u> is one of the most soughtafter and widely celebrated Corvettes ever produced, with many car enthusiasts crediting their first "split-window" sighting as being the catalyst that kicked off their automotive obsession. There's no denying that the impact the split-window Corvette's styling had on the auto industry, but what if <u>Chevy</u> tried to apply some of the sports car's iconic styling cues to the current-day <u>C8 Corvette</u>?



A digital rendering artist tried to answer that question by slapping the rear split window and b-pillar vents from the 1963 Corvette onto the rear of a C8 Corvette. The end result looks a bit strange, in our opinion, giving the C8 Corvette a hunched-over look that is less svelte and sporty than the actual production model. The rendering actually reminds us a bit of the Bugatti Chiron, which also has a mid-engine layout and features a very similar rear split-window design.

One advantage of this design could be cargo space. Even though the C8 Corvette's mid-engine layout limits the amount of cargo room, this design appears as though it could incorporate a rear interior parcel shelf where the split windows are.

In addition to the split-window design, this rendering also has some other interesting touches, including the center-locking wheels and Michelin slick tires from a Corvette C8.R and a redesigned rocker panel section.

As a reminder, the C8 Corvette Stingray is powered by a <u>6.2L LT2 V8</u> engine producing 495 horsepower and 470 pound-feet of torque when equipped with

the optional performance exhaust. An eight-speed dualclutch transmission and rear-wheel drive are standard, helping to propel the car from zero to 60 mph in a round three seconds.



2021 C8 Boasts Best Resale of "Any" Sports Car...

The 2021 Corvette Stingray has the best resale value of any sports car, according to the experts over at *Kelley Blue Book. K B B* recently

published the results of its 2021 Best Resale Value Awards, which



recognize vehicles that are projected to retain the highest percentage of their original value through the initial five-year ownership period. The publication's team of automotive analysts use a statistical model based on millions of different vehicle transactions to help accurately predict which vehicles will earn the highest five-year residual values, awarding the best performing vehicle in each segment with a Best Resale Value Award.

The 2021 Corvette is projected to have the strongest residual value of any other vehicle in the Sports Car category, with *KBB* predicting the mid-engine Chevy will retain 49.5 percent of its value after 60 months (five years) of ownership. KBB says the vehicle's impressive performance and sub-\$60,000 base price both contribute to its high projected resale value.

Here's what else *KBB* had to say about the Corvette's residual value:

"What's behind this success? Well, the C8 Corvette is a great-looking car with a fantastic lineage dating back to 1953. What's more, with a Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) still less than \$60,000, the 2021 Chevrolet Corvette represents one of the best values in today's market. With its 490-horsepower pushrod V8 engine, it offers true supercar performance at a price that's less than half of what you might pay for a Porsche 911."

Prices for the 2021 Corvette start at \$60,995 for the 1LT trim level, after receiving a \$1,000 MSRP increase earlier this week.

Barrett Jackson's Record Sales...

SCOTTSDALE, Ariz. – March 29, 2021 – Barrett-Jackson, The World's Greatest Collector Car Auctions, showed that the collector car market is thriving during its weeklong Scottsdale Auction at WestWorld of Scottsdale, March 20-27, 2021. Among the most notable sales during the week was the 1966 Shelby Cobra 427 Super Snake (Lot #1396) that sold for \$5.5 million and a 1967 Ferrari 275 GTB/4 (Lot #1394) that sold for \$2.475 million.



In total, 1,054 vehicles sold for over \$95 million, while over 1,000 pieces of automobilia brought in over \$4.4 million, and \$5.8 million was raised through the sale of charity vehicles, bringing the total auction sales to more than \$105 million with a 100-percent sell-through rate and over 95 world-record auction sales achieved. In addition to its quality collector car docket, Barrett-Jackson brought back the prestigious Barrett-Jackson Cup to recognize the talent and craftsmanship of custom car and truck builders. On Saturday, Barrett-Jackson Chairman and CEO Craig Jackson and President Steve Davis announced the "Ultimate Best in Show" was a 1970 Dodge Challenger known as "Havoc."

California Introduces Bill to Exempt Pre-1983 Vehicles from Emissions Inspections

Encourage support from lawmakers on this prohobby proposal:

SAN-supported legislation (A.B. 220) has been introduced in California to exempt motor vehicles prior to the 1983 model year from emissions inspection requirement. Current law requires the annual testing of all 1976 and newer model-year vehicles. The bill currently awaits consideration by the Assembly Transportation Committee.
