



Corvette Scores Dominant 1-2 Sweep at Daytona...

Corvette Scores Dominant 1-2 Sweep at Daytona...One year removed from a frustrating debut for the Chevrolet Corvette C8.R, Corvette Racing scored its first endurance race win with the eighthgeneration Corvette at the Rolex 24 at Daytona in a dominant 1-2 class finish.



Jordan Taylor made the decisive move around the outside of his teammate Tommy Milner in Turn 1 in the final hour and fended off the sister car to the finish en route to a narrow 3.519-second win.

Taylor and co-drivers Nicky Catsburg and Antonio Garcia overcame a stall in pit lane and a drive-through penalty in the final hours in the No. 3 Corvette, while the sister No. 4 entry overcame an intermittent gear selection issue that troubled them for much of the race. Garcia, meanwhile, was pulled from the eventual class-winning entry after testing positive for COVID-19 mid-race.

The Corvettes emerged as the class favorites in the opening hour and led at every hourly interval throughout the twice-around-the-clock enduro.

Both the Nos. 3 and 4 took turns at the front throughout the race, which started inauspiciously for the class when the No. 25 BMW of Bruno Spengler hit Kevin Estre in the No. 79 WeatherTech Racing Porsche 911 RSR-19 coming to the green flag.

Spengler was assessed a drive-through penalty for incident responsibility for the encounter.



Motor Authority Names Corvette 'Best Car to Buy'!

World's Fastest Corvette...

Referred to as the 'World's Fastest Corvette,' this highly modified 1984 has competed and held records in several Bonneville salt flat speed trial classes, reaching over 270 miles per hour. Juris Mindenbergs of Redmond, Wash. Acquired the car stock in 1986,



modifying it for Bonneville racing with the assistance of Mike Dorgan, Don Schellberg, Art Morrisson and Larry Kalsch with his expertise and dyno facility.

Later, owner Bobby Moore of Tulsa, Okla. Achieved many Bonneville class records, including eclipsing Mindenbergs' 1988 AA-GT class mark in 2004, which are highlight on the vehicle's rear window.

Mindenbergs reacquired the vehicle in 2016, donating it to a Museum in the Pacific Northwest in 2019.

C7 Z06 Enhanced Warranty for Overheating...

The C7 Chevrolet Corvette Z06's overheating problems way back in 2016. Chevy said it had a solution for owners with a new hood design that featured larger v e n t s a n d a n e w supercharger cover. Even then, Tadge Juechter said there was a relatively small



bunch of owners who were complaining about high temperatures.

Turns out, this book is still open at Chevy. Just recently, GM Authority reported that GM is issuing extended warranty coverage on 2015-2018 Z06s due to the overheating issue. The documents say that the Z06 "may have a condition where the vehicle may overheat and enter a reduced power mode when driven on a track at sustained high speeds in high ambient temperatures." We've contacted Chevy to confirm and search out more details, and will update when we hear back.

The warranty is meant to cover these overheating conditions and is good for seven years or 72,000 miles from when the car was originally put in service, regardless of ownership. If owners can provide proof that their vehicle is affected by way of a diagnostic code, photos or video, **Chevrolet** has a few gifts in store. Dealers will be able to install an updated radiator package (all Z06s) and an updated shift point calibration (automatic vehicles only) under warranty. Both those items are meant to keep your Z06 from overheating, but won't be provided unless your car is affected, according to the report.

If you like to use all 650 horsepower and 650 pound-feet of torque from the 6.2-liter supercharged V8 on the racetrack, we'd recommend taking Chevy up on their offer of enhanced cooling abilities.



C8 One Weeks Deliveries???

A merica's #1 Corvette Dealer receives his "one week" of C8's!!!!! That is what made a recent photo posted by Kerbeck Corvette all the more shocking.



Dozens of factory fresh C8 Corvettes just sitting on the showroom floor eager to unleash their performance on the world. Don't get your hopes up too much, all of them are already sold. However, more are arriving all the time to America's #1 Corvette dealer.

We recently spent some time talking to Dave Salvatore, the Corvette Manager at Kerbeck. He has been in the Corvette department since 1995, so he has been around since the tail end of the C4 generation. Salvatore spoke to us about the C8 experience from a dealership perspective, and how it compares to previous hot cars. We learned what the ordering process is like and a little bit about the customers themselves. Just who is buying all these new Corvettes? Probably the most shocking thing we learned is that the Corvettes in the cover photo represent only about HALF of the cars they currently have. They have two equal size showrooms, and this picture only shows one of them. They are nose to tail in new Corvettes.

Salvatore explained that he has never seen demand anything like this before. The C7 was hot for the first six or seven months but after that, they had showroom cars that were available for purchase. The first C8 rolled out of the factory nearly a year ago and there are still no showroom C8 cars available. Salvatore cannot even guess as to when they may have any showroom cars that folks can buy on the spot. The way things look now, it probably won't be this year.

C8 Outsells All Rivals Combined in Q4 2020...

The triple-digit jump in U.S. Chevy Corvette sales during Q4 2020 enabled the perennial sports car to remain the best-selling model in its class. In fact, the Corvette outsold all other rivals combined, with room to spare, including the Porsche 911, Porsche 718 (née Cayman/Boxster),



Mercedes-AMG GT, Mercedes-Benz SLC-Class, Mercedes-Benz SL-Class, Audi R8 (see running <u>Audi R8 sales</u>), Nissan GT-R, Ford GT (see running <u>Ford</u> <u>GT sales</u>), BMW i8, and Acura NSX.

The performance represents an improvement over the already-impressive Q3 2020 figures, during which time the Corvette accounted for 55 percent segment share. However, as we typically note, most contenders in this segment cost significantly more than the Corvette and naturally see lower sales volumes as a result.

The second-place Porsche 911 – the most cross-shopped rival with the C8 – sold only about a third as much as the Corvette, netting a decrease of five percent on a year-over-year basis and accounting for 16 percent segment share. The Porsche 718 line, comprised of the 718 Cayman and 718 Boxster, followed in third place with a 10 percent segment share. The Porsches were followed by a trio of Mercedes models with 6, 3, and 3 percent share each. All other models, including the Audi R8, Nissan GT-R, Ford GT, BMW i8, and Acura NSX, saw a segment share of 1 percent each or less.

The premium sports car segment expanded an average of nearly 58 percent to 15,101 units in Q4 2020, meaning that Corvette sales outpaced the segment more than two-fold.

With interest in the new <u>mid-engine Corvette</u> at an all-time high and <u>most C8</u> <u>Corvette buyers being new</u> to the Chevy brand, we expect Chevy Corvette sales to continue increasing in a steady fashion, so long as production continues uninterrupted at the <u>Bowling Green plant</u> that assembles the vehicle, and at the <u>GM Tonawanda Engine</u> <u>plant</u>, which assembles the <u>6.2L V8 LT2 engine</u> used in the C8 Stingray. It's worth noting that C8 production is <u>holding</u> <u>steady at 186 cars per day</u>.

Do You Regret Not Buying the C8 Z51 Package?

When the C8 Corvette was originally revealed, one of the biggest headlines was its incredible base price of just under \$60k. Of course, not many C8s are being sold with zero options, and prices can easily encroach on the sixfigure mark with a few options tacked on. But one option most C8 buyers seem to be going for is the Z51 package,



which offers up more power and a host of desirable performance goodies for an extra \$5,000 (or \$5,995 for 2021).

Many also point out that Mag Ride wasn't a standalone option in the 2020 model year, but now that it is, it makes the Z51 package even easier to skip. Plus, it seems that the summer tires included with the package are a bit of a turnoff for some as well.

Perhaps it should come as a huge surprise, but it seems like exactly no one that has chimed in so far regrets their decision to forego the Z51 option. Corvette Forum
