Pratt & Miller Corvette Racing Sells Out ...

Pratt & Miller, the Michigan-based engineering firm that runs the <u>Corvette</u> Racing program, has been sold to Oshkosh Corporation for \$115 million.

O s h k o s h Corporation, which operates out of O s h k o s h,



Wisconsin, is a manufacturer of industrial vehicles and equipment. The acquisition will give Oshkosh access to Pratt & Miller's engineering expertise in areas such as software, artificial intelligence, robotics and autonomous and electric vehicle systems, among more, although Pratt & Miller will continue to operate independently of Oshkosh and the other brands in its portfolio.

The acquisition includes all elements of Pratt & Miller's business, including its motorsports division. The company's racing operations, which include the factory-backed Corvette Racing program and <u>Camaro GT4.R</u> customer race car, will be unaffected by the sale. Pratt & Miller also lends <u>Chevy</u> some engineering talent for its NASCAR Cup Series and IndyCar Series efforts, including for advanced vehicle and aerodynamic testing and simulation solutions.

Pratt & Miller was founded by Gary Pratt and Jim Miller in 1989 and has been in charge of the Corvette Racing program since 1999. The engineering company also helped develop other GM race cars and programs, including the <u>Pontiac</u> GTO.R for the Grand American Rolex Series and the GT3-spec <u>Cadillac</u> ATS-V.R.

While Pratt & Miller is well-known for its motorsports endeavors, it is also heavily involved in the development of tactical and combat vehicles as well as next-generation military prototypes. Similarly, Oshkosh is involved in the development and production of various military vehicles and mobility systems through its Oshkosh Defense brand.

2014 Corvette C7.R Listed For Sale Online...

The 2014 <u>Corvette</u> C7.R that Chevy raced to victory at the 2015 24 Hours of Daytona and 12 Hours of Sebring has been listed for sale online for an eyepopping sum of \$950,000 USD.



This Corvette C7.R is the third

chassis that was manufactured by Pratt & Miller after it introduced the C7.R for the 2014 racing season. Any complete Corvette C7.R would be worth big bucks, but No. 3 is the winningest Corvette C7.R chassis in existence, so it is particularly valuable. Its winning record began when Corvette Racing took back-to-back victories in it at Long Beach and Laguna Seca in 2014 before the team went on to win both the 6 Hours of the Glen and Mosport with the car later that year, as well. In 2015 this was the chassis that Antonio Garcia, Jan Magnussen and Ryan Briscoe raced to victory at the 2015 24 Hours of Daytona and 2015 12 Hours of Sebring – two of the biggest endurance races in all of motorsport. The trio also took a podium at Mosport with the car that year.

Pratt & Miller is now looking to offload this car from its collection. The race team recently delivered the car from its Michigan headquarters to high-end car seller Fantasy Junction for consignment, which currently has it listed for just under \$1 million. Many race cars that are sold to privateers are slightly altered or have been restored, but this car remains almost exactly as it was when it was being professionally raced in IMSA and the FIA WEC. Pratt & Miller recently installed a fresh engine in the car, however, which was dyno tested at a healthy 574 horsepower. As a reminder, the Corvette C7.R is powered by a race-bred Small Block 5.5L V8 engine, which is paired with a six-speed sequential transaxle.

Have \$950,000 handy and the driving skills necessary to handle a highdownforce, Daytona 24 Hour-winning race car? If you answered yes to that question, consider dropping Fantasy Junction a line before someone else scoops up this rolling piece of Chevy motorsport history. We get the feeling it won't be available for very long.

Tom Peters Joins NCM Team ...



A familiar face from General Motors is re-emerging from retirement to join the team at the National Corvette Museum. Tom Peters, former Director of Design for the GM Performance Car Studio and 2019 Corvette Hall of Fame inductee, has

joined the Museum's curatorial team effective January 2021 as Consulting Curator of Exhibits. Tom is no stranger when it comes to assisting with Museum exhibits, having co-curated 'Car-toon Creatures, Kustom Kars and Corvettes: The Art and Influence of Ed "Big Daddy" Roth', a special exhibit that officially opened in January, 2020 and continues through April, 2021.

immensely hammered by measures aimed at preventing the spread of Covid and it looks like its going to a while before things are back to anything close to normal.

The Tesla Model Y and the Ford Mustang Mach-E sparked plenty of interest in electric cars while GM's full-size SUV's, the Land Rover Defender and Ford F-150 PROVED THAT "OLD DOG" could learn new tricks.

But even through all of those models more than met ex[ectations, the "one car" that impressed Gary more than any of them was the Chevrolet Corvette Stingray, because it exceeded them all!!!!!!

GM Brands Rank High in JD Power 2020 Survey ...

GMC and **Buick** have been recognized in the latest J.D. Power 2020 U.S. Sales Satisfaction Index Study. The two GM brands placed s e c o n d a n d t h i r d respectively in the Mass Market segment.



The J.D. Power U.S. Sales

Satisfaction Index looks at satisfaction among new-vehicle buyers and "rejectors" (or rather, a potential buyer who decides to purchase somewhere else) with regard to dealership sales experience. The study calculates buyer satisfaction using six individual factors, which, listed in order of importance, include "delivery process (28 percent); dealer personnel (21 percent); working out the deal (19 percent); paperwork completion (19 percent); dealership facility (10 percent); and dealership website (4 percent)."

Meanwhile, "rejector" satisfaction is based on five factors, including "salesperson (28 percent); price (27 percent); negotiation (18 percent); dealership facility (14 percent); and variety of inventory (13 percent)."

Now in its 35th year, the latest 2020 study was based on responses from 35,816 buyers who purchased or leased their new vehicle between January and June of 2020. The study was fielded between July and October of 2020. The responses were then used to calculate a single score for each of the brands studied, with a total of 1,000 points possible.

In the Mass Market segment, two GM brands, GMC and Buick, performed

well, clinching second and third place, respectively. GMC scored 804 points, while Buick scored 803 points. Mini was the highestranked Mass Market brand with 824 points, while Ford was fourth with 798 points. <u>Chevrolet</u> ranked eighth with 787 points, slightly above the segment average set at 784 points.



GM Brands Rank High in JD Power 2020 Survey ...

Another of the U.S. GM brands, <u>Cadillac</u>, was ranked fourth in the Luxury segment with 825 points. Infiniti and Porsche also scored 825 points in the segment, while Mercedes-Benz, Lexus, and Lincoln were ranked third, second, and first, respectively, with 826 points for Mercedes-Benz and Lexus, and 827 points for Lincoln.

Among the 2020 study key findings was improved satisfaction among buyers participating in pandemic-related buying activities, such as completing paperwork online, as well as enhanced take rates among buyers who reviewed products online.







New C8 Arrives with Unusual Mistake...

Given all of the Chevy Corvette C8's production setbacks, there are bound to be s o m e mixups.

However, one unlucky owner was shocked to see his

brand-new Corvette have a painfully obvious mistake. According to a thread on Corvette Forums, the owner recounts specifically optioning his sports car with a specific color combination. Instead, he received a very strangelooking C8.

If this Chevy Corvette C8 production defect hasn't jumped out at you, pay close attention to the boomerang-style trim piece that connects the door and the rear quarter panel. The top half of the trim features the Carbon Flash Metallic option. The second half of the boomerang is finished in Torch Red, color-matched to the rest of the body. While a mixup like this could easily be remedied on most other models, the C8 Corvette is a different story.

If messing up one Chevy Corvette C8 door wasn't enough, this particular C8 had both of its doors mixed up. How both doors can be improperly assembled and sneak past quality control is a real mystery. According to the owner, the dealership is currently working with GM to fix the issue before the vehicle goes through its pre-delivery inspection. However, finding spare parts could be tough.

Thankfully for the owners of these brand-new cars, the issue is easily fixable once the proper parts arrive. Additionally, the first owner we covered reported the dealership actively working to solve the issue. Hopefully, it won't be long until the trim on his C8 finally matches.

History of Auto Air Conditioning...

Goldberg Brothers - The Inventors of the automobile Air Conditioner



Here's a little known fact for automotive buffs, or just to dazzle your friends. The four Goldberg brothers, Lowell, Norman, Hiram, and Maxwell, invented and developed the first automobile air-conditioner. On July 17, 1946, the temperature in Detroit was 97 degrees.

The four brothers walked into old man Henry Ford's office and sweettalked his secretary into telling him that four gentlemen were there with the most exciting innovation in the auto industry since the electric starter.

Henry was curious and invited them into his office. They refused and instead asked that he come out to the parking lot to their car. They persuaded him to get into the car, which was about 130 degrees inside, turned on the air conditioner, and cooled the car off immediately.

Henry got very excited and invited them back to the office, where he offered them \$3 million for the patent.
