Get to Know the Dual-Zone Automatic Climate Control

The dual-zone automatic climate control can be adjusted using traditional switches or the touch screen. Walk through these steps to ensure you know how to use and demonstrate the system.

There are **3 ways to adjust the set temperature**, using the buttons on the side of the touch screen or the touch screen itself. Try these actions yourself:

Raise the set temperature on the driver's side by **pushing the red arrow button** alongside the screen

Now raise the set temperature in a different way. **Touch the screen** where the driver's set temperature is displayed

A new screen comes up. Touch the icon of the red arrow or blue arrow to adjust the temperature up or down

Now, move the slider up or down to adjust the set temperature

You can touch different sections of the climate control screen to bring up other menus and make other adjustments.

- 5 Touch the driver's side seat heater icon, then **touch the seat heater icon** to turn the seat heater on. Touch it again to lower the level of heat or turn it off
- If the screen has reverted to Home, touch the set temperature area again and **touch the "Sync" icon**. This will synchronize the driver's and passenger's set temperature. "Sync" can can be set from either the driver's or passenger's menu

Now touch a the center section of the HVAC screen. On the new screen, **touch Auto**, which changes the automatic control to **Full Auto**. ("Auto" controls everything <u>except</u> fan speed. "Full Auto" provides automatic control of the fan speed as well.) This same screen allows manual control of mode, fan speed, recirculation and Max A/C

One section of the climate control touch screen is customizable.

From the Home Screen, **touch the Settings icon**. Then **touch the General tab**

Scroll down if necessary until you see "Climate Control."

10. Touch the "Customize Climate Button" bar to bring up 4 choices:

- 11. Select "**Max A/C**" then touch the Home icon again. Now, as you can see, the customizable portion of the climate control screen shows Max A/C, which sets both driver and passenger's side temperatures to Lo temperature, full fan speed, recirculation and ventilation function to maximize cooling in the vehicle
