



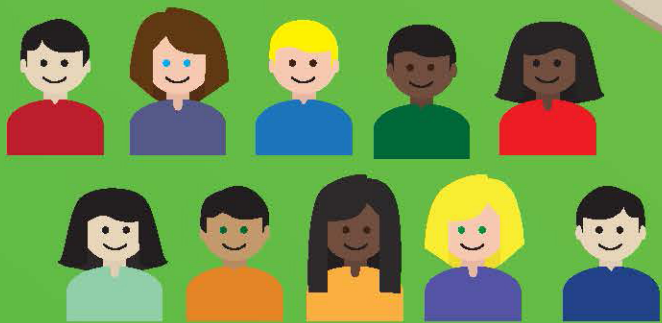
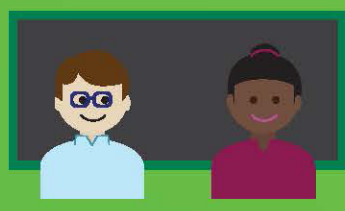
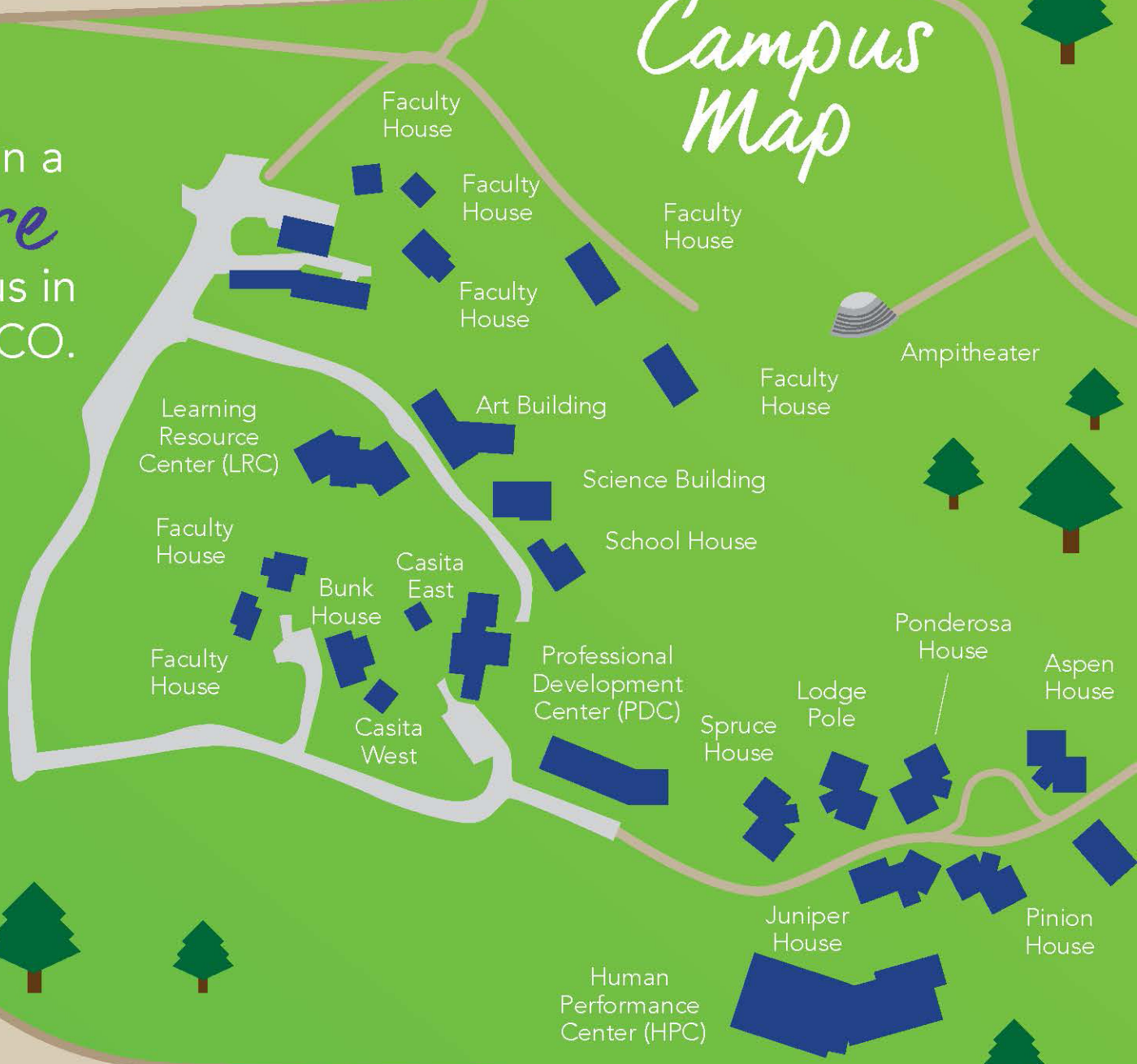
A Student Journey at Eagle Rock School



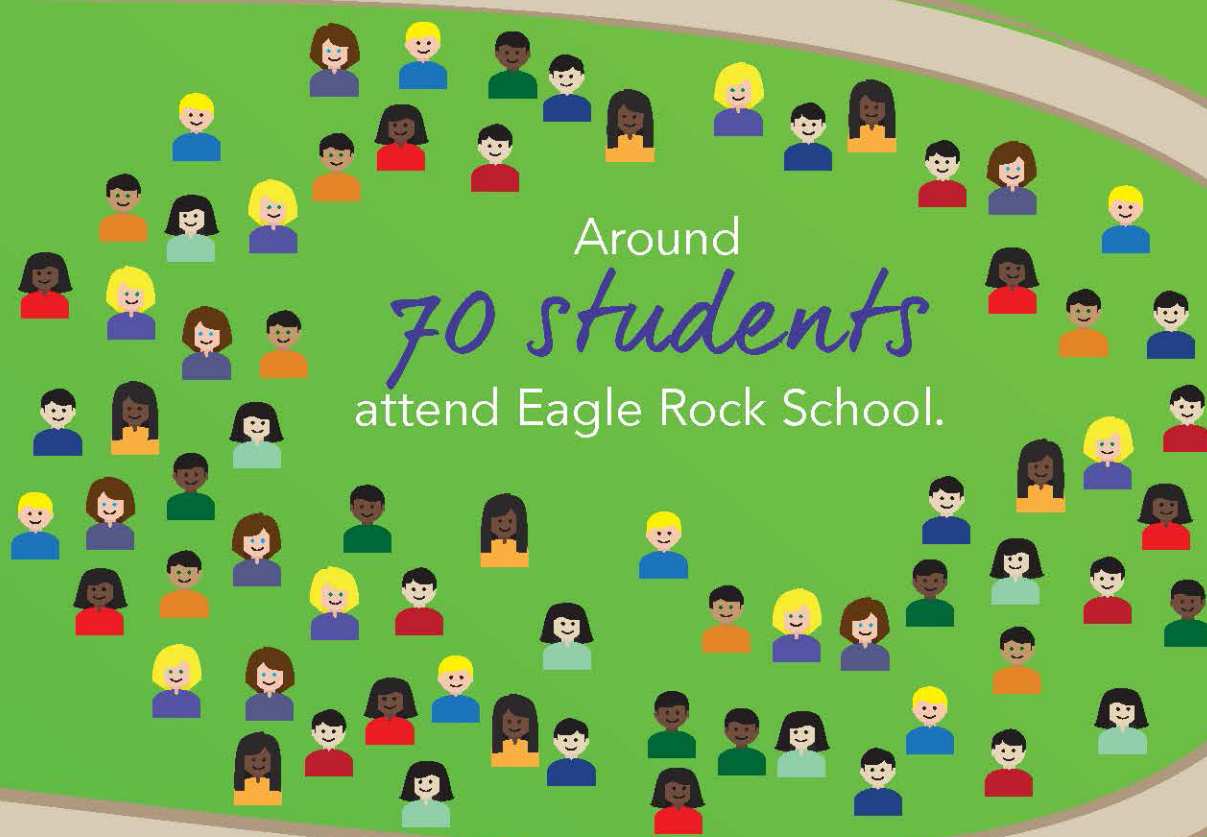
Eagle Rock School is a year-round, residential and full-scholarship high school for students who have not experienced success in traditional academic settings.

The school supports youth, aged **15-17** with limited financial means.

The campus is located in a **640-acre** mountainside campus in Estes Park, CO.



On average, there are **10 students** and **2 instructors** per class.

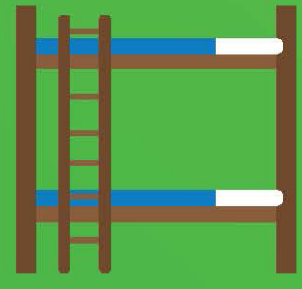


Around **70 students** attend Eagle Rock School.

To be accepted
an applicant must demonstrate a passion and motivation to actively pursue intellectual and personal growth, and attain personal achievement outside the classroom.



New students begin with a staple rite of passage – **24 days** on a wilderness course.



Students live in co-ed houses with two separate sleeping quarters. They strive to create a family atmosphere where students feel safe, emotionally nourished and comfortable.



Students are immersed in math, science, music and literacy, and are exposed to hands-on learning opportunities.

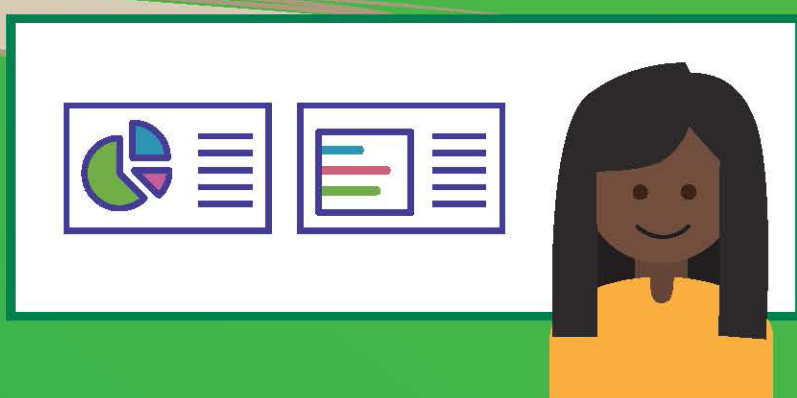


Daily intramural sports and outdoor activities help build teamwork skills and comradery.



Teachers often come to Eagle Rock to improve their abilities and learn new methods before heading back to teach at more traditional schools.

Every trimester, students are required to share what they've learned through a 15-minute presentation of learning. They are tasked with considering both personal and academic growth, and future learning goals.



Eagle Rock students have gone on to do amazing things. One graduate, Matt Rutherford, even became the first person in history to complete a nonstop, single-handed sailing voyage circumnavigating North and South America.

The companion Eagle Rock Professional Development Center works with high school educators and administrators around the country to help them create engaging educational experiences in their own schools. It also helps mentor Eagle Rock's teachers.
