



SUMMERIZING PROCEDURES



NOTE: Some RV's have unique & different water supply systems. This document is intended to be generic, in nature. Therefore certain procedures may vary on some units.

1. Ensure all drain valves are closed on the black & grey waste tanks.
2. Ensure all taps & faucets (including outside shower) are closed and the water heater bypass valves are still in the "winterizing" position.
3. Attach a non-toxic, food grade fresh water hose to the city water inlet using a suitable water pressure regulator and slowly open the water supply tap to pressurize the system. Watch & listen carefully for possible water leaks.
4. If no leaks are detected, slowly open each tap and faucet beginning with the fixtures located furthest from the city water entry. Allow each fixture to flow until all the air and antifreeze is displaced out and the water is flowing clear and smoothly. **NOTE: Fixtures may spurt & sputter as air pockets are displaced.**

Fixtures include: bathroom sink, tub/shower, shower hose & head, kitchen sink, toilet & outside shower. Certain RV's may also contain water filters, icemakers and/or washing machines.

5. Re-install drain plug into the water heater, using an approved sealant or teflon tape to seal the threads.
6. Turn the water heater valves to summer position.
7. Repeat step (4) with the hot water taps & faucets only. **NOTE: It may take several minutes to displace all the air from the water heater.**
8. Close the fresh water drain valve & fill the fresh water tank.
9. Test the system again using the water pump.
10. **You are now ready to Go RVing! HAVE A GREAT SUMMER!**

IMPORTANT NOTE: Anytime your RV is not being used, it is a good idea to ensure the house batteries are fully charged and the supply wires are disconnected to prevent discharge. Deep cycle RV batteries do require regular charging AND also require regular maintenance. If the batteries require additional fluid, use distilled water only. Always keep the batteries and posts/connectors clean & free of corrosion.



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TIPS & TRICKS

ONE OF THE MOST COMMONLY OVERLOOKED MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES ON RV'S IS CLEANING & DISINFECTING THE FRESH WATER TANK. WE NOW CARRY A PRODUCT SPECIFICALLY FOR THIS PURPOSE. WE RECOMMEND THIS BE DONE, AT MINIMUM TWICE PER YEAR – ONCE FOLLOWING SUMMERIZING, AND AGAIN 1/2 WAY THROUGH THE SEASON.

WE ALSO CARRY DRINKING WATER FRESHENER. USE THIS PRODUCT REGULARLY TO TAKE THE STALE AND/OR PLASTIC TASTE OUT OF THE WATER.



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
