While there are so many thoughtful features to love in the Telluride, here are several unique items to highlight with customers when discussing its mastery of everyday utility.

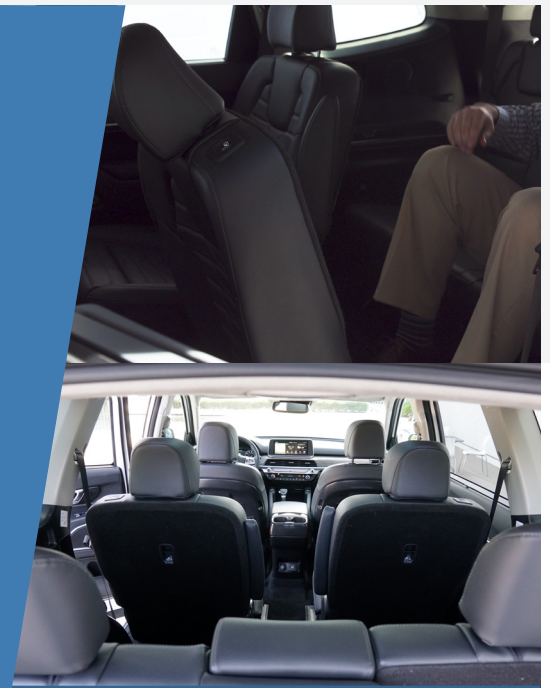
COMFORT

- Reclining third-row seats (std.)
- Roof climate control (allows for two second-row cup holders) with diffuse vents (std.)
- Second-row side window shades (EX and SX)
- Heated and ventilated second-row seats (avail. SX Prestige Package only)



CAPABILITY

- Seating for 8 (LX and EX); Seating for 7 with captain's chairs (S and SX)
- Near class-leading cargo volume behind third row of 21 cu. ft. ^{*2}
- Two-way luggage board (provides multiple cargo configurations) (std.)
 - » Fits two large 28-inch suitcases with board open and third-row seats up
- Towing package (avail. on EX and SX only) has capacity of up to 5,000 lbs. ^{*3}
 - » Comes with tow hitch and self-leveling rear suspension, which automatically calibrates vehicle height to compensate for heavy loads
- Three LATCH child seat anchors; two in second row and one in third (std.)
